Early Years

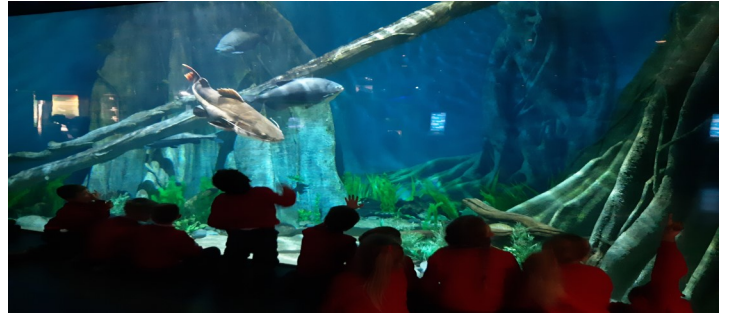


Fox Cubs have had a very busy week learning five new nursery rhymes as part of World Nursery Rhyme Week.

Each class are busy preparing for their class stall and linking this to instruction and persuasive writing in their English lessons.

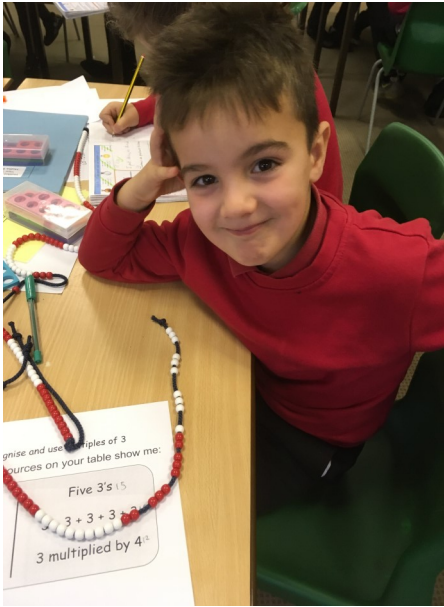
There will also be: a tombola, a sweet and chocolate tombola, a raffle, a cuddly toy tombola, a refreshment and cake stall and bottle bingo.

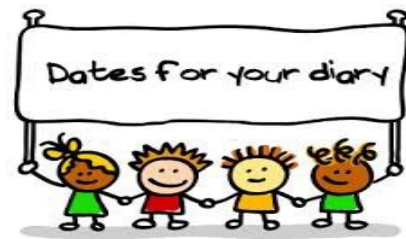
