




Year 1 Phonics

Floor Standard

The floor standard is the minimum standard for pupil attainment and/or progress that the government expects schools to meet.

In 2018, a school will be above the floor standard if:

 at least 65% of pupils meet the expected standard in English reading, English writing and Mathematics:

OR

the school achieves sufficient progress scores in all three subjects. At least -5 in English reading,
 -5 in Mathematics and -7 in English writing.

To be above the floor, the school needs to meet the attainment **OR** all of the progress elements.
