

## A message from Mrs Atherton



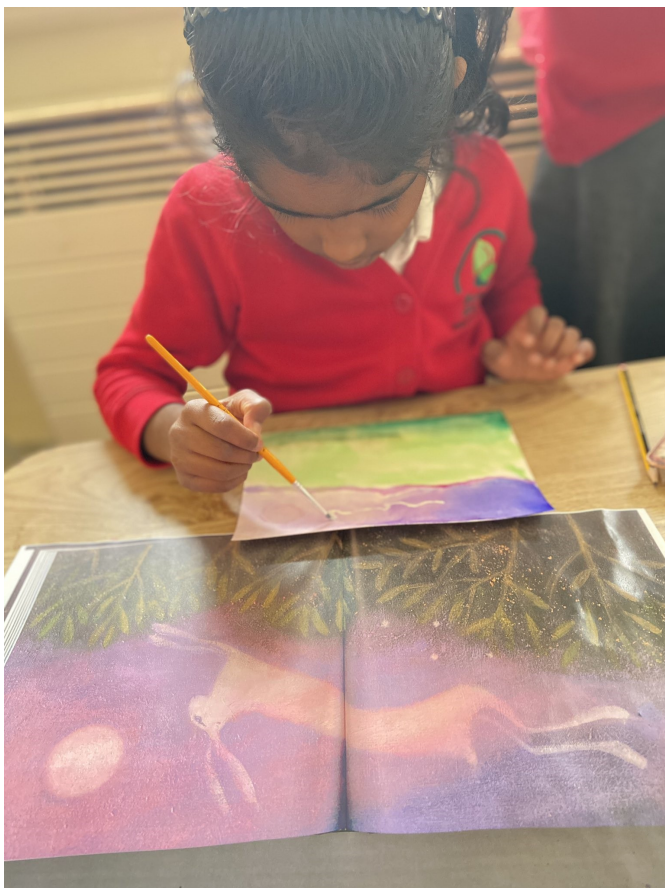

We loved our whole school art day based on painting and inspired by the book 'The Hare and the Moon: A calendar of paintings'

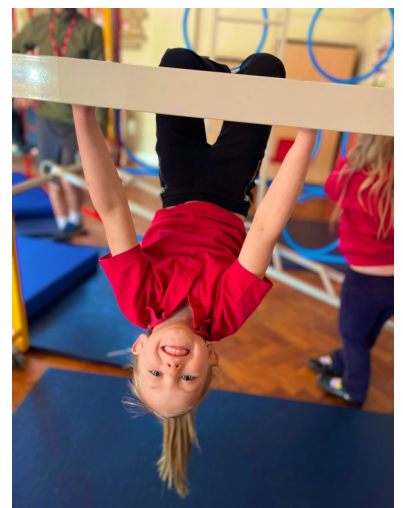




*Our Key Stage One plant spotters hard at work this week!*
