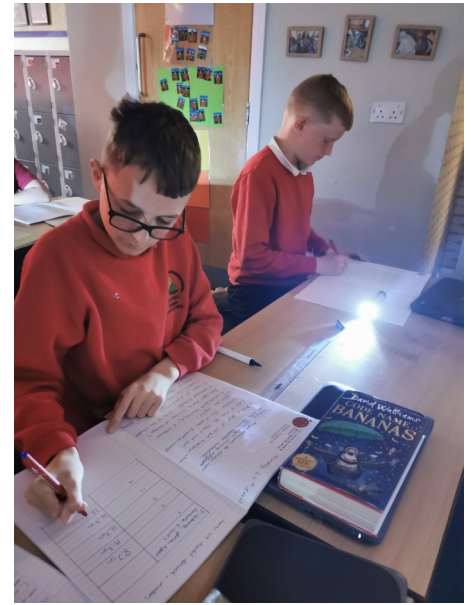
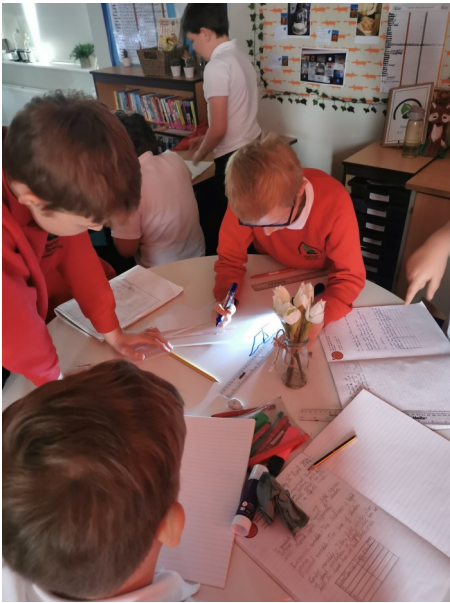
This superstar was the youngest ever winner of 'Sports Star of the Week.' He has settled into Tiny Toadstools so well and is very resilient in his P.E lessons.

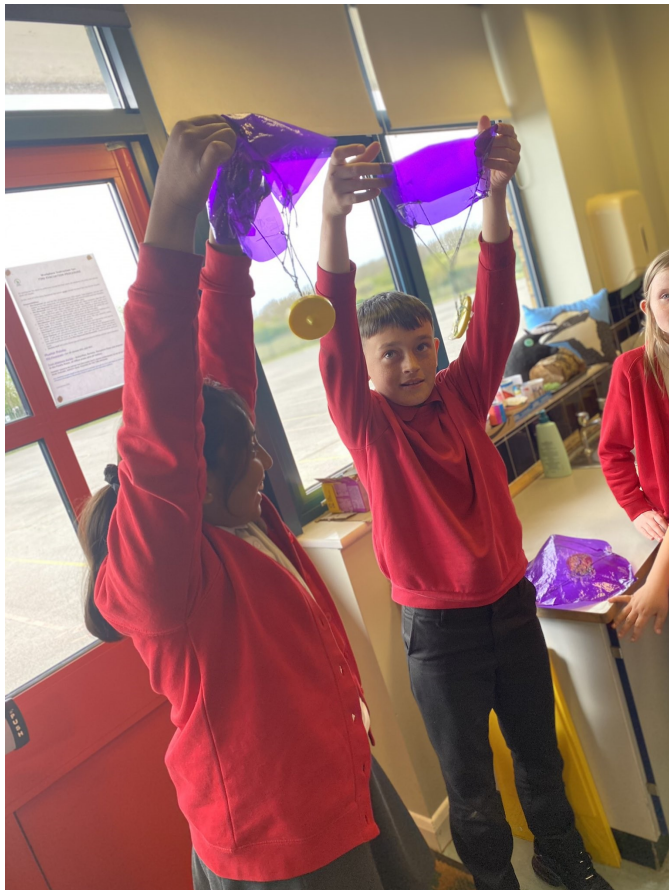


Science in Year Six
