The colours are so vibrant - well done Owls.



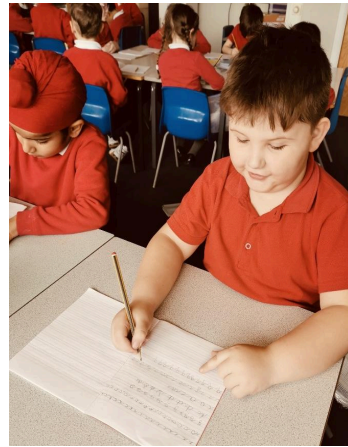
All of the children in school have explored sculpture in Art this academic year.
