This half term seems to have flown by! Thank you all for the incredible kindness and support that you show to our staff. We are lucky to be part of such a special community.

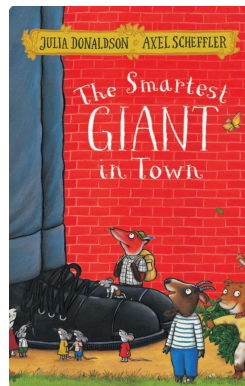
Thank you also for your cake donations and for coming to support our tombola. We have raised £150 towards the Purple Pig Farm visit to school which is for all children in March.

History was brought to life for Key Stage 1 this week. They couldn't stop talking about the school room and the prison at The Castle Museum.

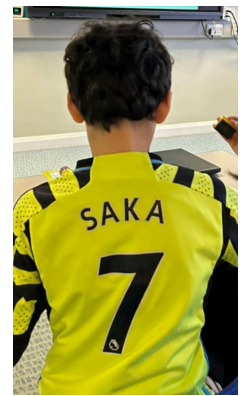
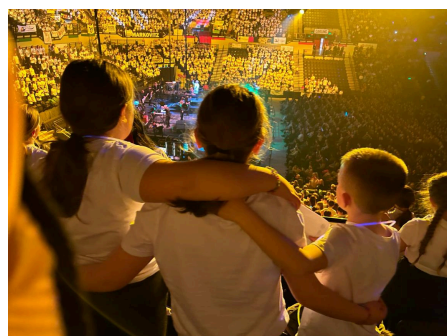




Hedgehogs had a wonderful time watching The Smartest Giant in Town by Julia Donaldson at The Grand Opera House.
