World Book Day was such a wonderful way of celebrating books and reading. The children looked absolutely fantastic and the entries for the egg competition were stunning!







































Careers Update We are working to inspire the children regarding different careers. Since the last newsletter, we have been visited by our very own Mrs Bharath,
